AWARDS

There are two categories for prizes: amateur and student (under 18). Within each category, up to three prizes will be awarded:

First place \$150
 Runner-up \$100
 Honorable Mention: \$25 *Natureworks* gift card

There will be special recognition for Best in Show and Best Black and White Photograph.

All entrants will receive a free pass to visit the Museum once during the exhibition.

All awards are funded by the New Mexico Museum of Natural History and Science Foundation.

The first-place entry becomes the property of the Museum. Additionally, we request digital files of each prize-winning photograph. Copyright of the images will remain with the photographer. Images will only be used to promote the NatureScapes Photo Salon on the Museum website and social media.

HOW TO ENTER

The NatureScapes Photo Salon is open to photographers of all abilities. Photographers do not have to be residents of New Mexico, but only photographs taken in New Mexico will be included in the competition. Previous winners may enter.

Each entry includes an entry form, a single printed image, and an entry fee.

The entry fee is \$15 for the first photograph, and \$5 for each additional photograph, for a maximum of four photographs. Entry fees can be paid by check or cash. Please make checks payable to **NMMNH Foundation**.

Photographs can be taken with a film or digital camera. Minimal manipulation is acceptable but nothing should be added to the image. All manipulation must be disclosed upon entry.

The Museum will frame and mat all photographs selected for the exhibition. The mats for standard printed images have an opening of 10.5 inches by 13.5 inches and we suggest submitting images 11x14 to fill the opening. Panoramic images must have widths no less than 9 inches and no greater than 12.5 inches.

Deliver or mail entries (including payment) to the address below. If you mail your print(s), you must include a self-addressed stamped envelope for the photos to be returned, or you must pick them up at the Museum after the exhibition. Mark on the outside of the envelope that this is a NatureScapes entry.

ENTRY/JUDGING

Judges will select approximately 30 photographs including the winning entries, for display at the Museum. The odds of winning depend on the overall number of entries received; last year there were approximately 60 entries.

Judging	11 - 15 September	Entries will be judged on technical quality, composition, creativity and depiction of the theme.
Winners announced	18 - 22 September	All photographers will be notified by mail.
Exhibit opens	21 October	Winners will be publicly announced and prizes will be awarded during the exhibit opening 10:00 - 11:00am.
Exhibit closes	19 January 2018	Photographs will be repackaged and marked for pick-up beginning: Thursday, 1 February .
